Drawing Materials:

- Paper
- Crayons
- Water color markers / felt tip markers
- Chalk
- Pens / pencils

Things to draw/scribble on:

- Paper in various shapes, sizes and types
- Chalk boards
- Paper plates
- Dry erase boards

Paint materials:

- Finger paints
- Tempera paints
- Watercolor paint sets with brushes and paper

3-D Materials:

- Play dough
- Clay
- Wood for gluing or for carpentry
- Pipe cleaners
- Modeling compound

Collage Materials:

- Paste or glue
- Paper in various types, colors and shapes
- Magazine pictures
- Egg cartons
- Felt remnants, cotton balls, sequins, feathers, buttons, glitter

Tools:

- Safe scissors
- Staplers

- Tools to use with play dough (stencils, sponge painters, rollers, brushes of various sizes and shapes)
