



Phonemic Awareness is the ability to hear and manipulate sounds in words.

Phonics/Alphabetic Principle: The ability to associate sounds with letters and use the sounds to form words.



Vocab/Comprehension


Word Callers Only! Will be a very small number of students



Vocabulary: The ability to understand (receptive) and use (expressive) words to acquire and convey meaning.

Comprehension: The complex cognitive process involving the intentional interaction between reader and text to convey meaning.
