



after using them.**




**Don't leave toys and other items laying around the house.

A First Aid Kit should contain the following: bandages and antiseptic for cleaning the wound, an ice pack, gauze bandages, small scissors, adhesive tape, tweezers, surgical rubber gloves, antibiotic ointment, and cotton balls. It is also a very good idea to include a First Aid Handbook.




Dispose of all dangerous items carefully.

Put safety plugs in all unused outlets.


NEVER stick anything in an electrical outlet. It could cause you to be burned or shocked. Ask your parents to help you plug in all electrical items.






