


Shell Tell

Teach sets, numerals, and number words—at the “seashore”!

Materials: ten white paper plates, markers, scissors

How To:

1. Fold the paper plates in half. Cut the edges so the plates resemble shells.
2. Draw sets of dots (you can also use stickers) on the front of the “shells” and write the corresponding numerals inside.
3. Demonstrate how to count the objects on the front, and then open the shell to verify the amount.



And...

- * Write number words on the front and matching numerals inside.
- * Write math facts on the front and answers inside.
- * Write a series of numbers with a blank (such as 1, 2, __, 4, 5). Children guess the missing number (write it on the inside).
