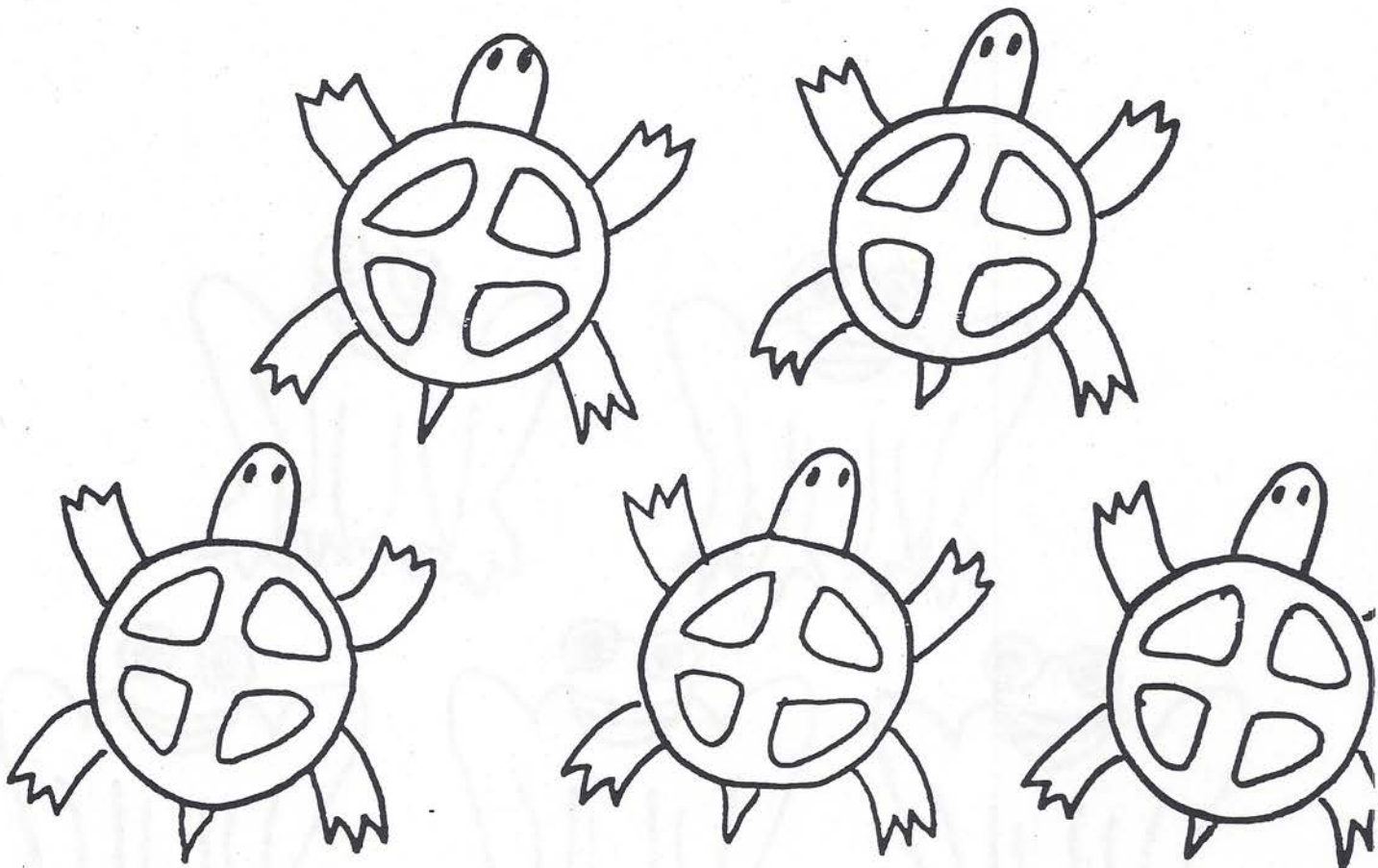


TURTLES

Up swims another, and then there are five.

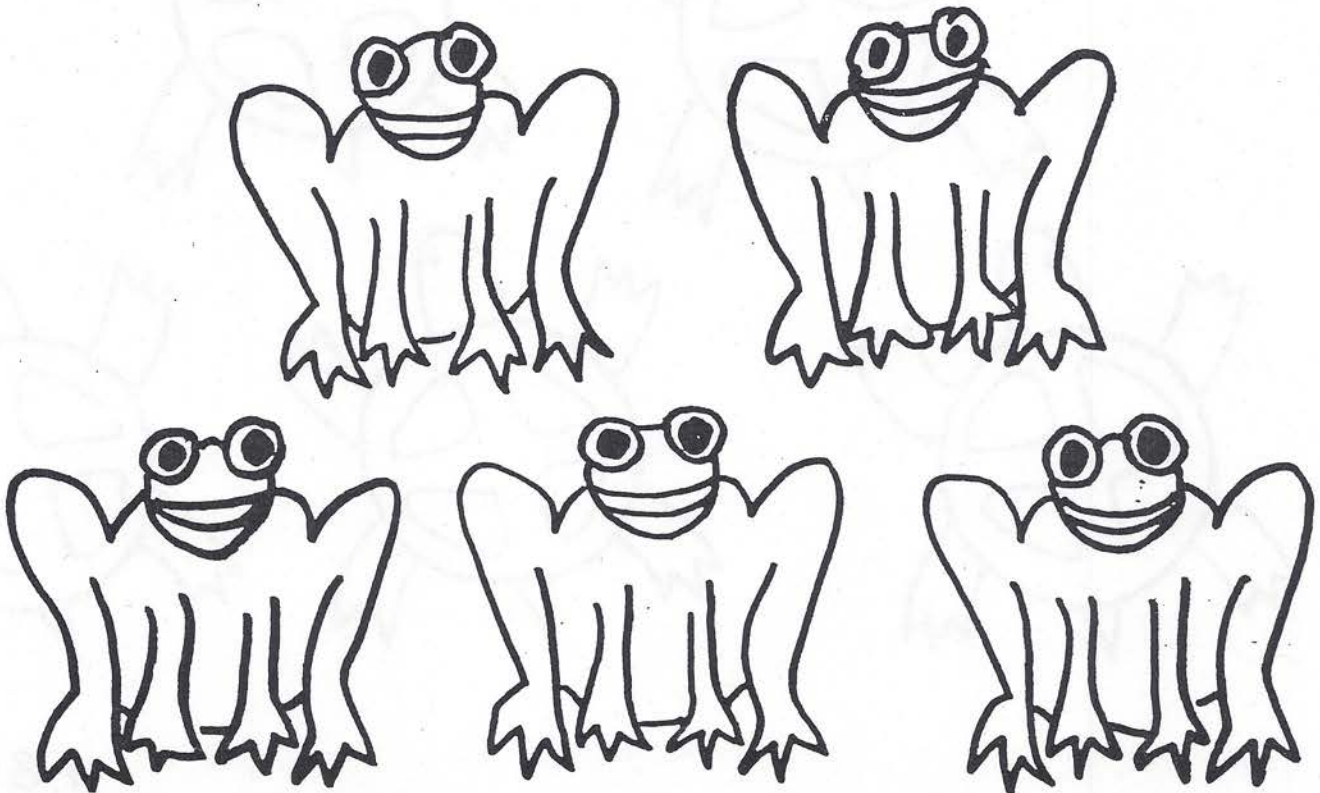


FIVE LITTLE SPECKLED FROGS
