


The community is the area where you live. Aren't you proud of it when it looks beautiful?



All the people living in a community must work together to keep it beautiful. You, too, must do your part.




Be sure you clean up after yourself whenever you leave a recreational area.




Put your litter in a litterbag when you are driving in the car.

# cafeteria




Your school cafeteria is part of the community. Keep it clean. Dispose of your trash as you leave.



Please keep the community clean. Can you help this child get her trash to the wastebasket where it belongs?




Did you know that every individual produces about 3.5 pounds of trash every single day? Even you.




Where do you suppose all this trash goes?



Most trash is put in a landfill. A landfill is a big, big space filled with trash.




Another way to dispose of trash is by burning it in a waste-to-energy plant.

Other trash, such as plastic, glass and paper, is recycled to make things like benches, clothing, fences, playground equipment, bottles, cardboard and paper.




Many schools use recycled paper. Does yours?
