Santa Handprint

YOU'LL NEED:

Washable paint in red, white and pink
Colored cardstock
3 paintbrushes
A black marker
Baby wipes

HOW TO:

1. Prepare paint in separate cups with separate paintbrushes.
2. Paint child's hand to match the image above. Be sure to work quickly so that the paint does not dry!
3. Press the painted hand firmly on the cardstock.
4. Wipe hands clean with the baby wipes.
5. Once the paint is dry, add additional facial details with the marker.
6. Enjoy this handprint keepsake or consider making a handmade greeting card for a loved one!

Santa Hat Brownie Bites

YOU'LL NEED:

1 pan of your favorite brownies (cut into rounds) or ready-made brownie bites
12-16 strawberries, washed and hulled
Vanilla buttercream icing
A piping bag

HOW TO:

1. Cut off the base and stem of each strawberry so it is flat.
2. Pipe a ring of icing on top of each brownie piece.
3. Place a strawberry upside down on each brownie, pushing slightly to secure in place.
4. Pipe the tip of each strawberry with a dot of buttercream to complete the Santa hat.
5. Eat, share & be merry!

Santa's Pants Pots

YOU'LL NEED:

1 terracotta pot
Red paint
Black paint or electrical tape
1 washer (can be found at the hardware store)
Permanent glue

HOW TO:

1. Paint the base of the pot with red paint.
2. Paint the lip of the pot black or wrap it with a piece of black electrical tape.
3. Using permanent glue, adhere a washer to the black lip of the pot to make Santa's belt buckle.
4. Fill the pot with a small poinsettia, a Christmas tree or treats for your teacher!
