

# Jacksonian Democracy 1829-1853

## Who Was Who during the Jacksonian Democracy?

- **Davy Crockett** was a famous frontiersman, soldier, and statesman who died at the Battle of the Alamo. Although he played up his "frontier" reputation to rise in political life, history shows that his strong sense of humor and storytelling abilities won him many friends and much favor publicly.
- **Lucretia Mott** and **Elizabeth Cady Stanton** organized the Seneca Falls Convention for women's rights in 1848. This happened because Mott and Stanton had been refused the right to speak—or even sit down—at the London 1840 World Anti-slavery Convention, where they were delegates.
- **Horace Mann** was the first secretary of education for Massachusetts and started the first school for teacher training. Mann believed that all U.S. citizens should receive a free education, and he also believed that children should attend school by neighborhood in order to form common bonds.
