

Lesson Plan #6 of 6

Unit: Stories of the World

Topic: Australia

Objectives:

1. The students will be able to comprehend proper care for teeth through the read aloud story.
2. The students will be able to sing "Brush Your Teeth" to the tune of "Row Row Row Your Boat" as a class in rounds.
3. The students will be able to recognize healthy and unhealthy foods and procedures for their teeth by cutting out pictures in magazines and gluing onto proper cardboard tooth.

Materials:

Storybook – Possum Magic by
Overhead of song ("Brush Your Teeth")
Magazines with pictures of food in them
Cut outs of teeth using poster board (2 yellow, 2 white)
Glue sticks
Scissors

Anticipatory Setting:

1. Teacher will introduce the book I Have a Loose Tooth and ask students what they think the book might be about and why.
2. Teacher will read book. While reading, teacher will address proper care of teeth, healthy foods, and ask questions about the story.
3. Teacher will review the book and ask students to share stories about their experiences with teeth.

Procedures:

1. Teacher(s) will review the rhyme/rhythm of "Row Row Row Your Boat."
2. Teacher(s) will use overhead to introduce the song "Brush Your Teeth" (sung to rhythm of song above).
3. If needed, teacher(s) will give a break in the lesson.
4. Teacher(s) will resume lesson by asking students if they know what it means to sing in rounds. If not, teacher(s) will explain what the word means and how to do so.
5. Teacher(s) will divide class into 3 groups (for singing in rounds).
6. Students will sing "Brush Your Teeth" in rounds.
7. Students will return to desks and divided into groups to make posters.
8. Students will be given scissors to cut pictures of healthy and unhealthy things for teeth out of magazines (what they cut out will depend on which group they are in).

9. Students will use glue sticks to glue the pictures they cut out to the appropriate poster.
10. Students will present posters to class when all groups are finished.

Assessment:

Student performance will be based on their ability to cooperate with classmates to create posters with healthy and unhealthy items on them, as well as their ability to recall and sing the "Brush Your Teeth" song.
