

## Directions for Making the Mini-Books



1. Make a double-sided copy of each mini-book template. (Note: Each mini-book takes up two back-to-back pages in the teaching guide.)

2. Cut along each dotted line.



3. Place spread B on top of spread C and spread A on top of spread B.



4. Check to make sure all the pages are in the correct order.

5. Staple the mini-book along the spine, then fold along the solid line.



6. Invite children to read the story on their own and practice writing the two featured sight words.
