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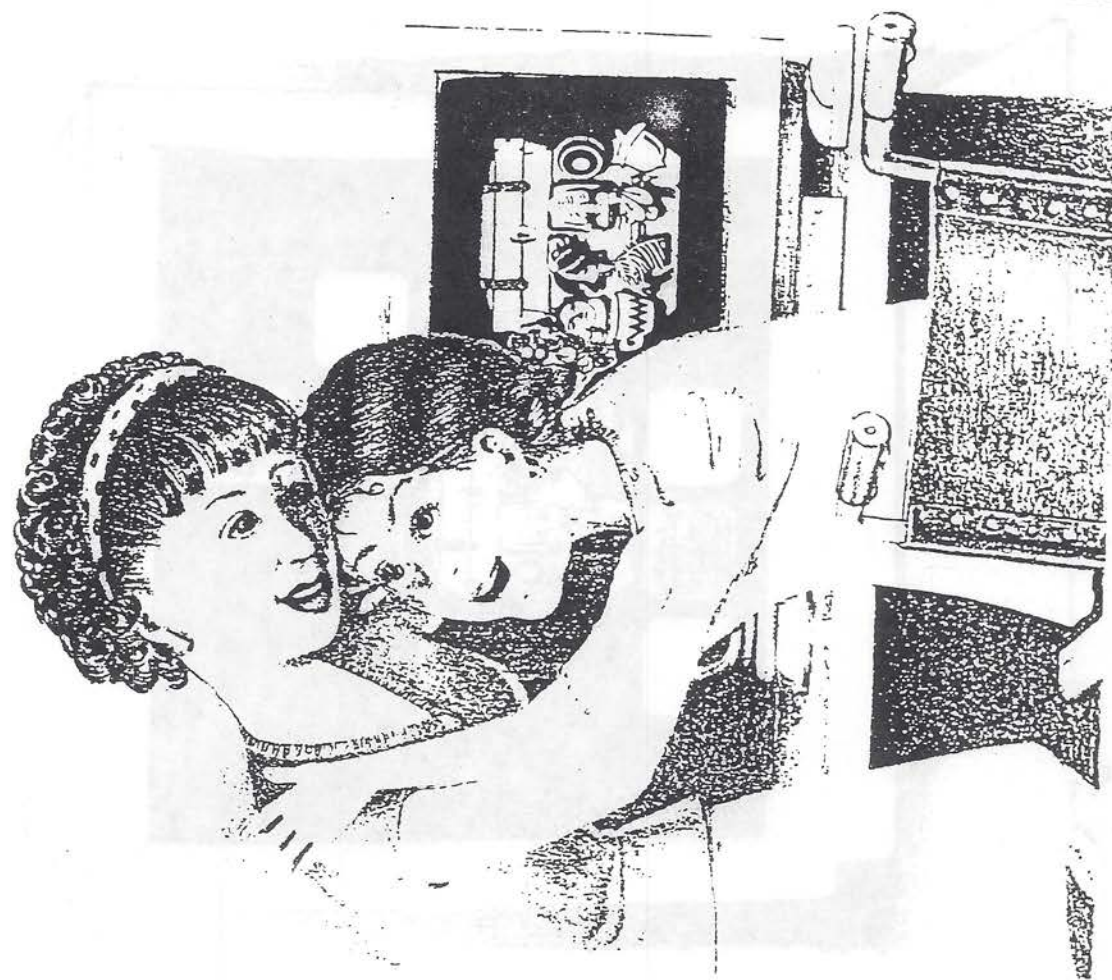

Phonics Skills: Initial consonants x, y, z, qu, Word families *-ug*, *-up*, *-ut*

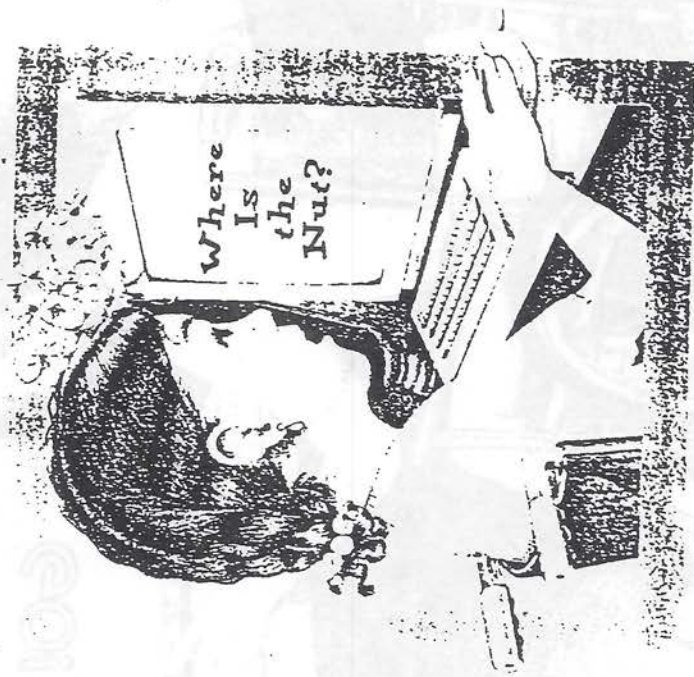
