

Ideas for 100th Day of School

- On the 100th day of school, put 100 ice cubes in a glass container. Allow the children to guess where the water line will be when the cubes melt. Start this activity early in the morning.

- 100 Day Trail Mix Each table of five students is given a snack item: popcorn, pretzels, peanuts, raisins, miniature marshmallows. They then make 10 rows of 10 to have 100 pieces of their treat. After each table has completed, the items are placed in a large bowl and mixed. Each child receives a portion of the treat.
- Link up with a couple of other classes and make a mural of 100 painted children's hands together celebrating 100 days of true friendship (include teachers handprints and other special people in the school).
- Send a letter home to the parents asking them to send 100 pennies to school with their children. Each child counts their pennies into 10 rows of 10. Roll the pennies and donate to a local charity.
