On the Job

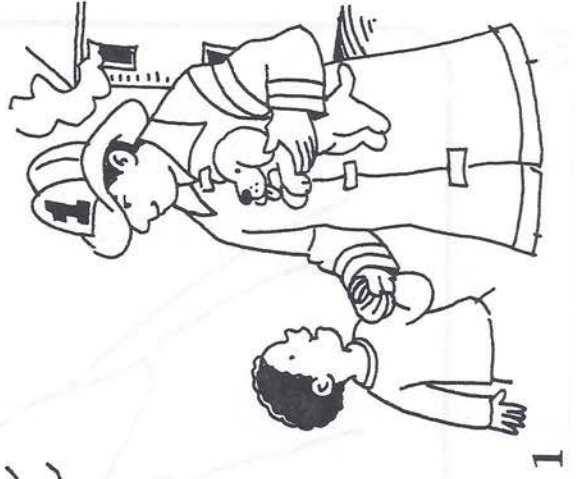
Firefighters have a dangerous but important job. They work together to put out fires. Some firefighters drive the fire engine.

Choose three tools or articles of clothing and write how you think they keep a firefighter safe.

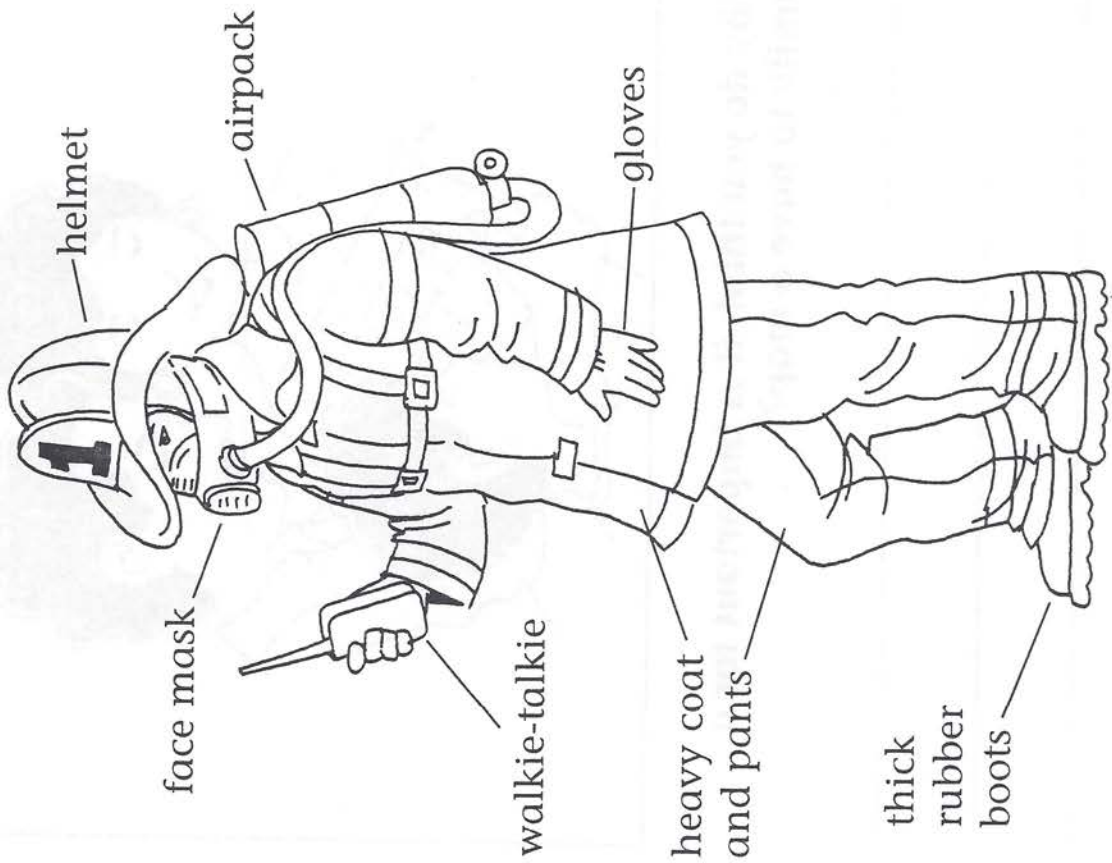

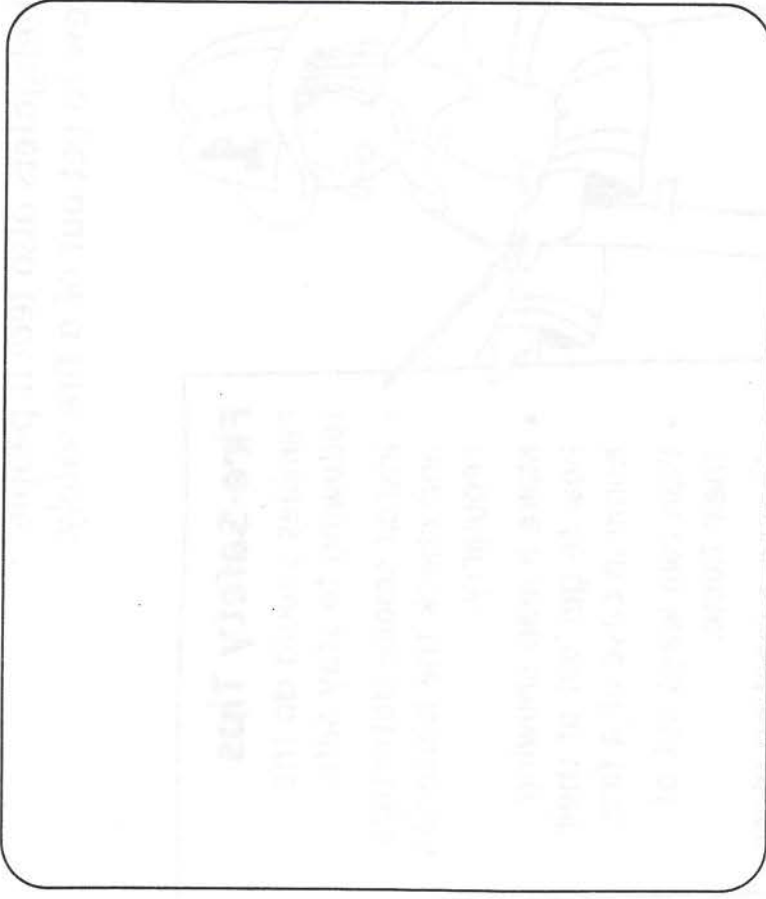

Firefighters wear special clothing. The clothing keeps them safe when they are putting out a fire. Firefighters use special tools, too.



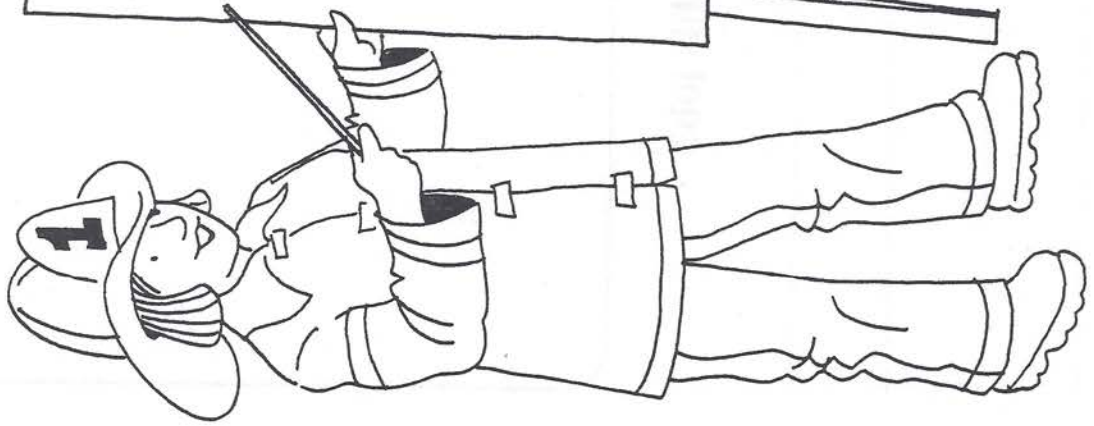
If you were a firefighter, which job would you want to do? Draw a picture of yourself doing this job.

Staying Safe

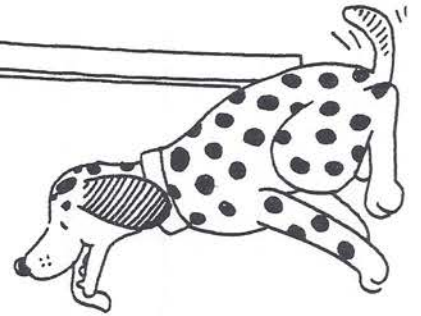
Firefighters also teach people how to get out of a fire safely.
