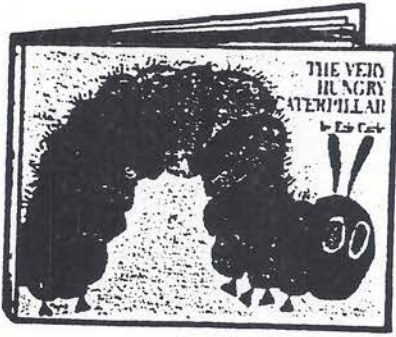

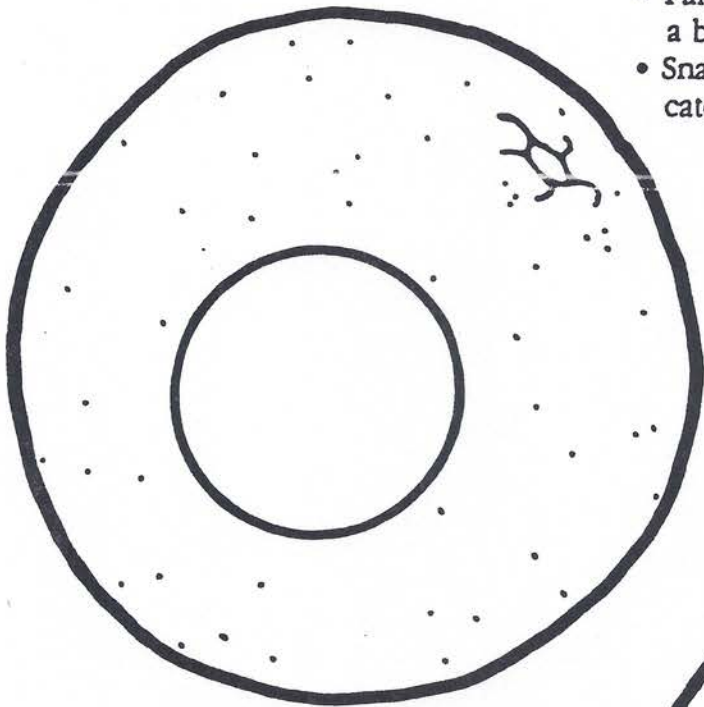

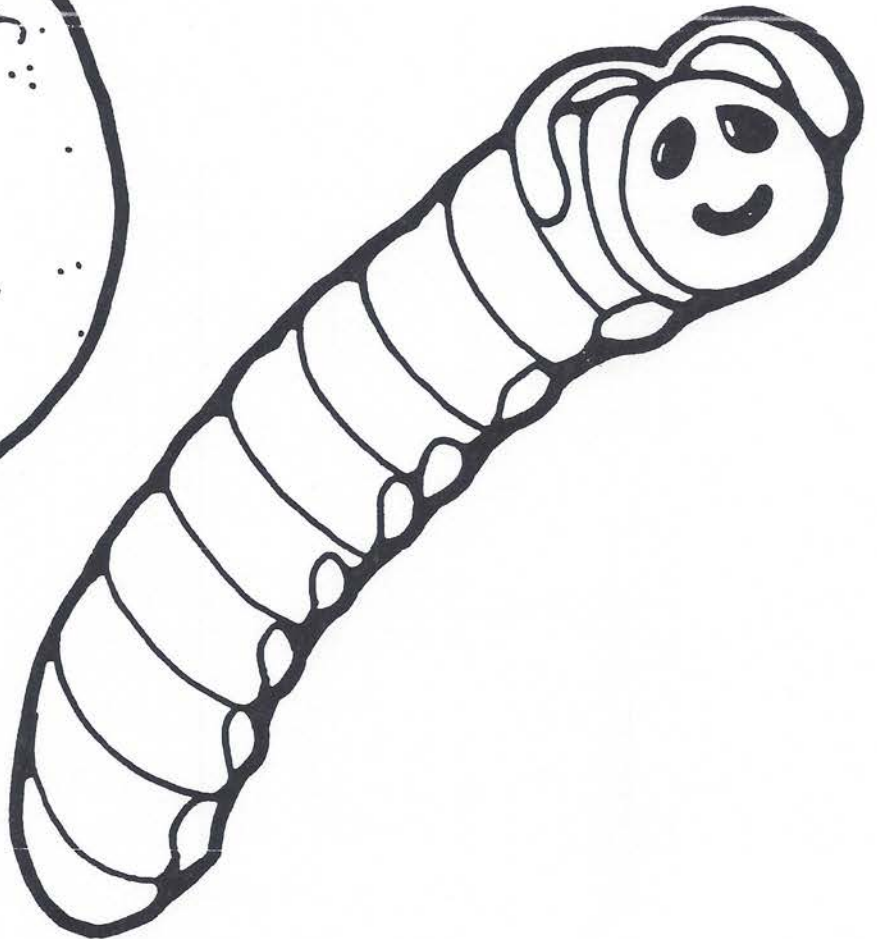

- Snack on—and identify—the same fruits as the caterpillar enjoyed.

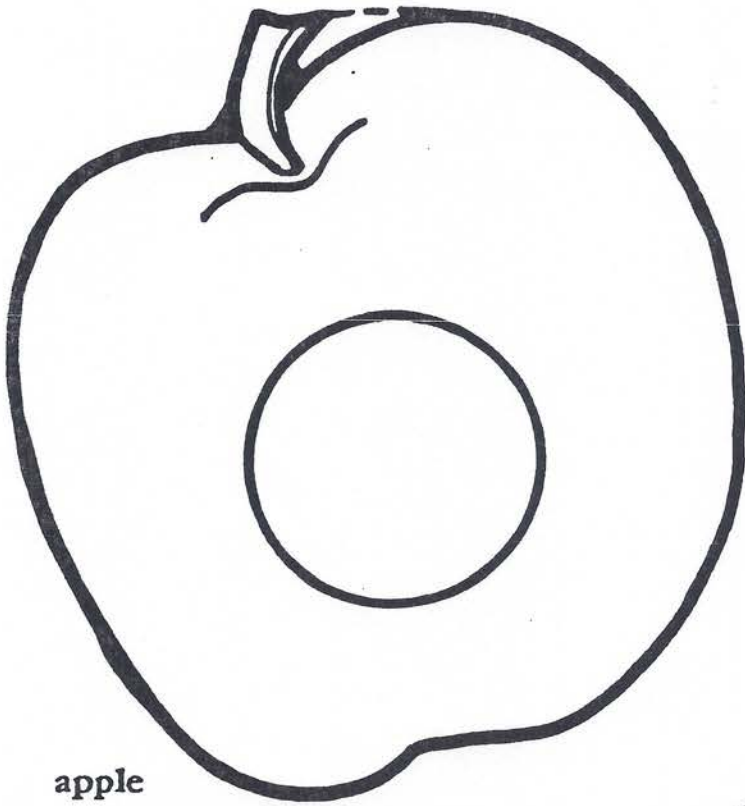

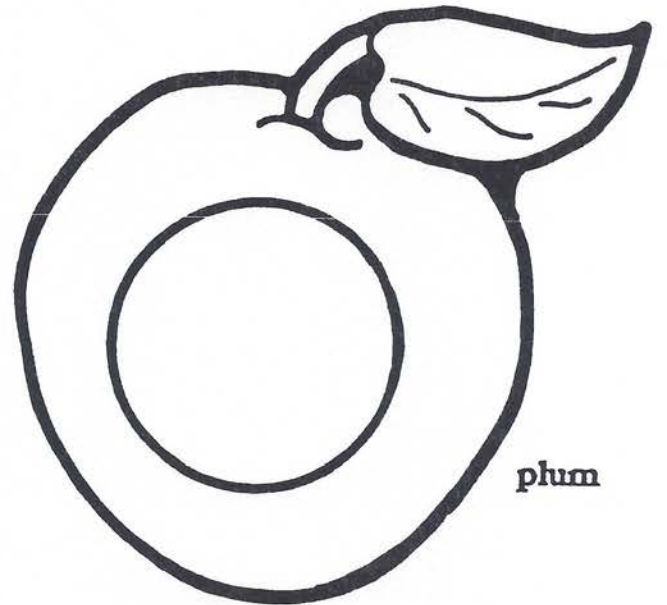


Pattern Requirements:

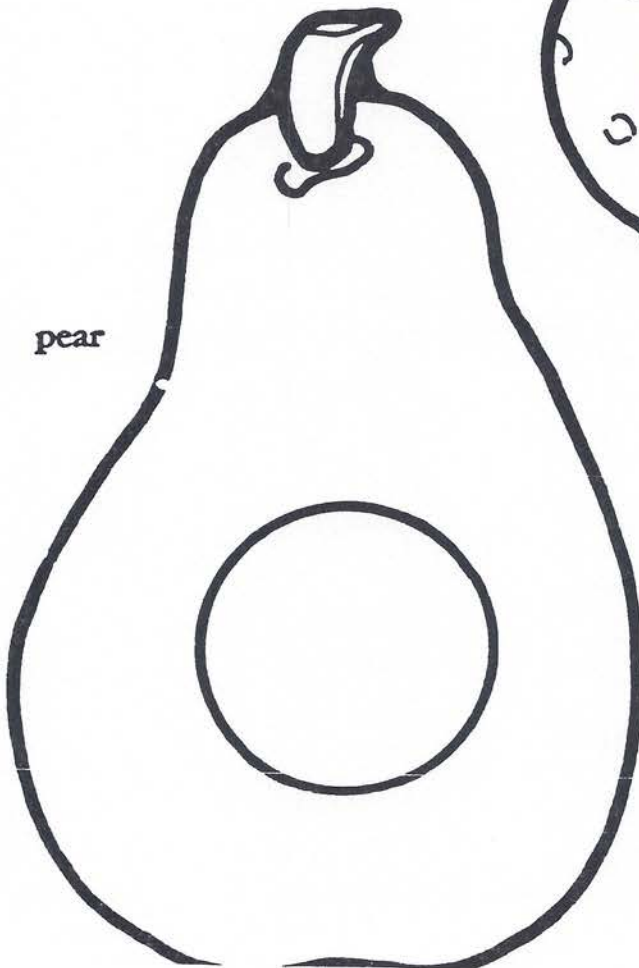
- One green caterpillar
- One orange orange; cut out the hole



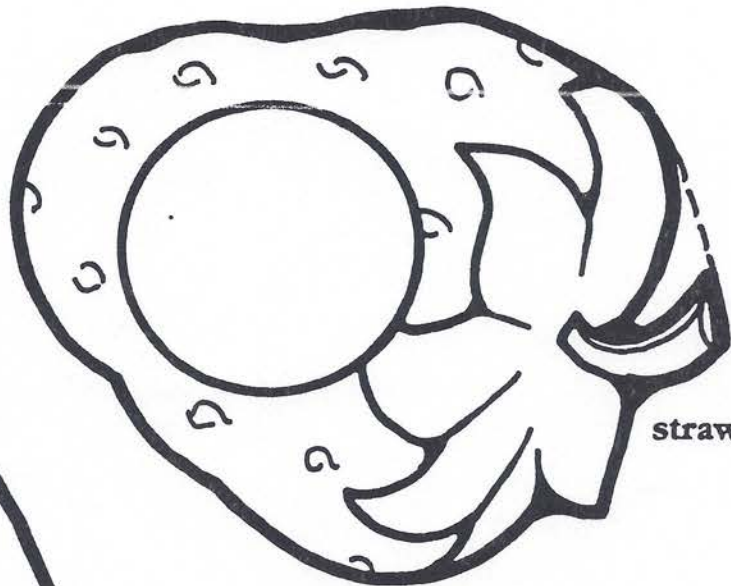

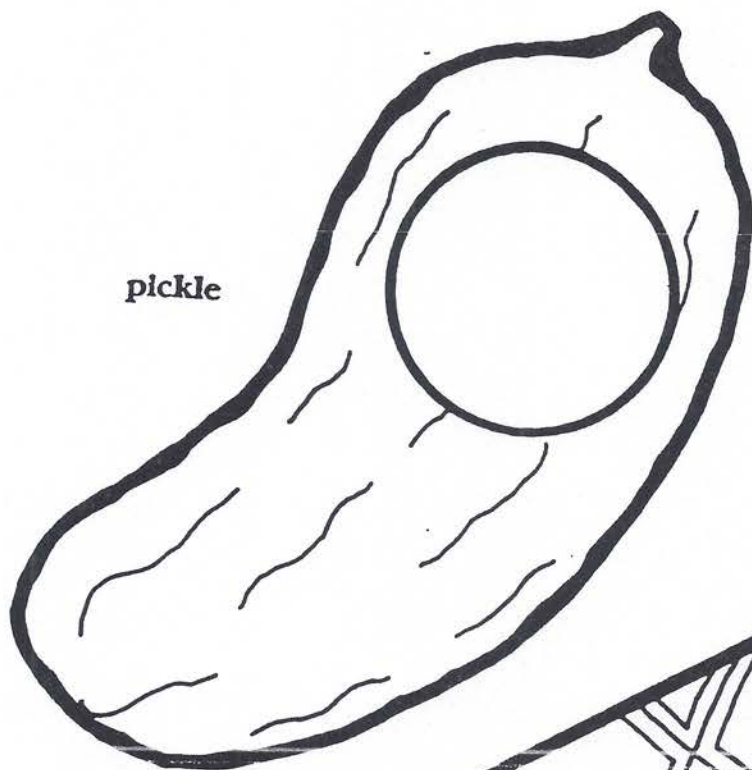

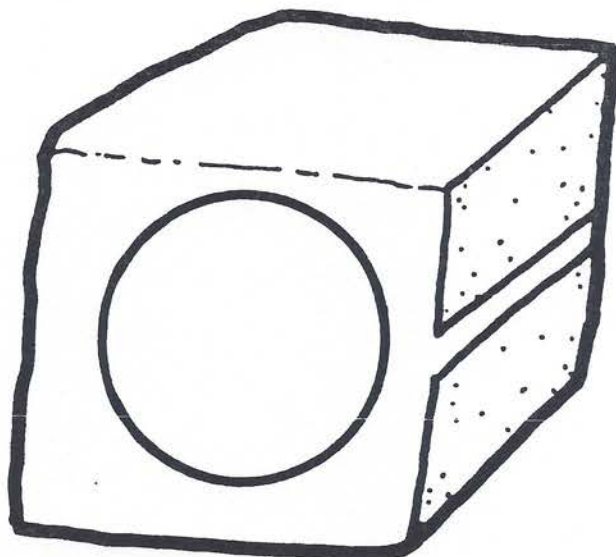
Pattern Requirements:

green stem

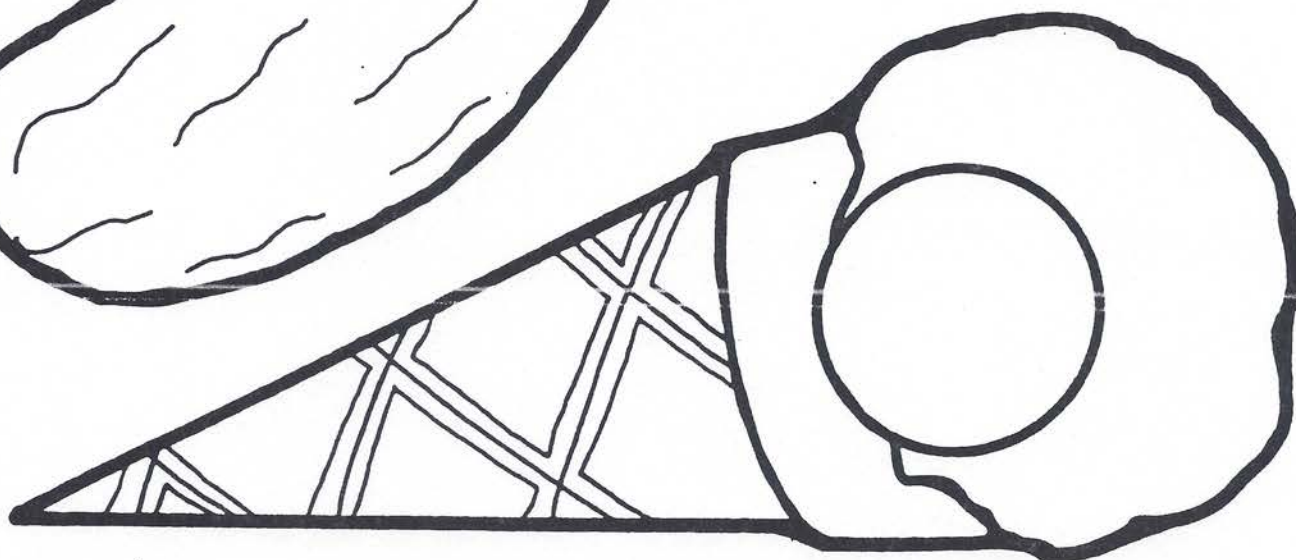

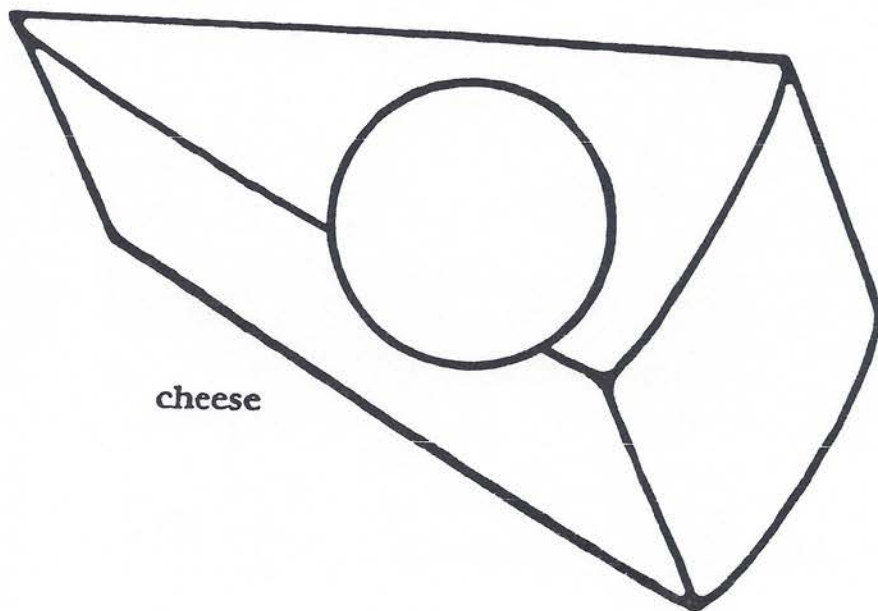

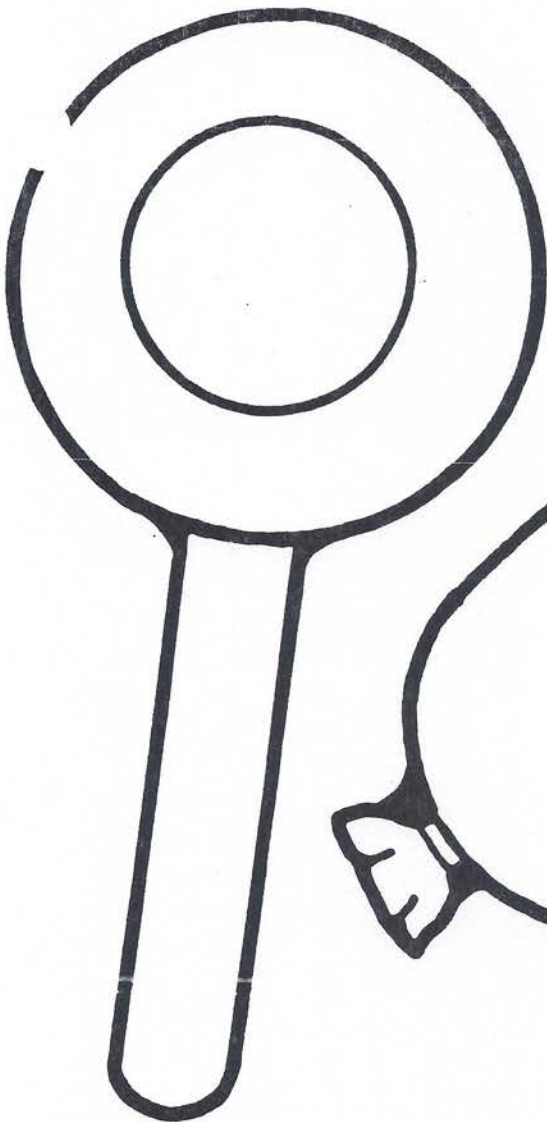

cheese

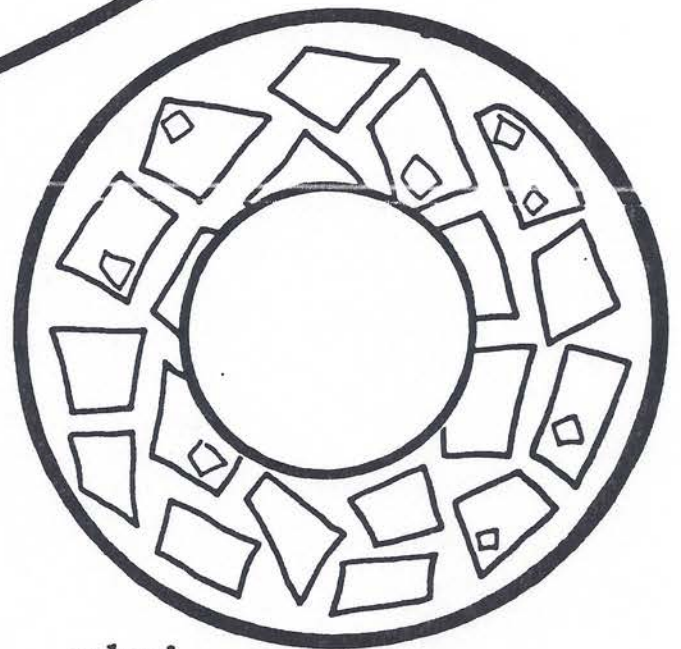

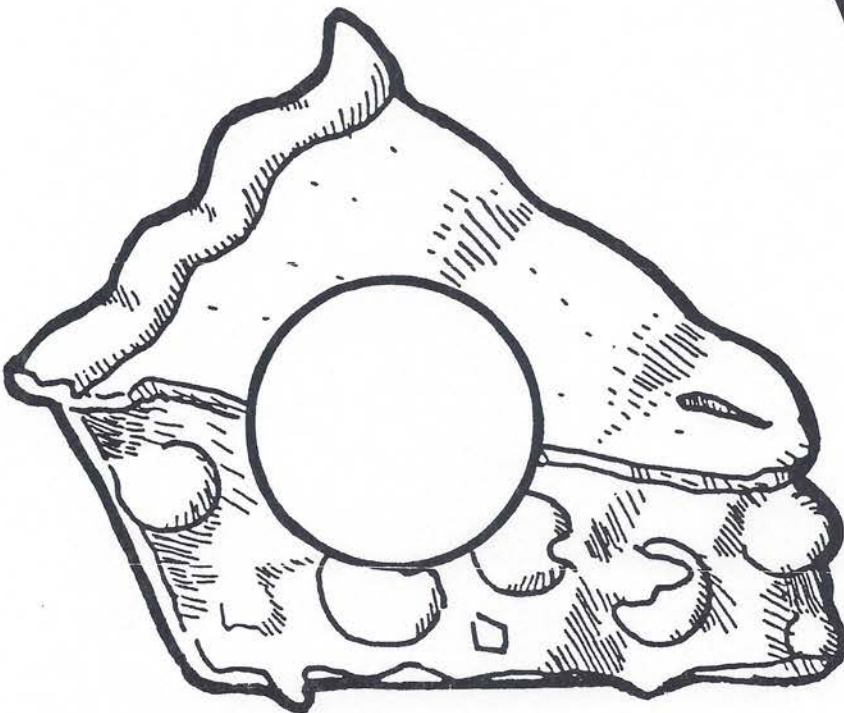

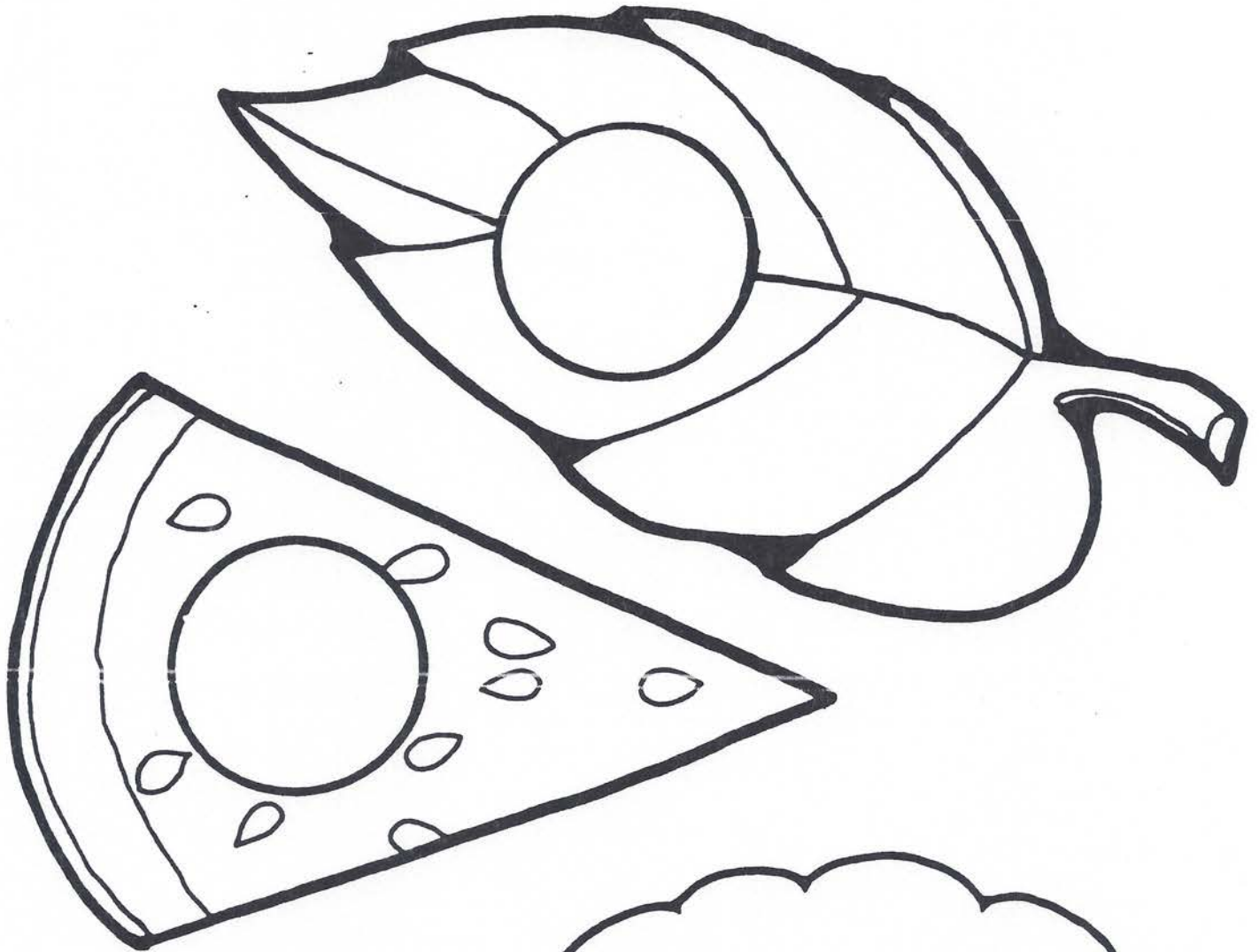

NOTE: Cut out the hole in the center of each.

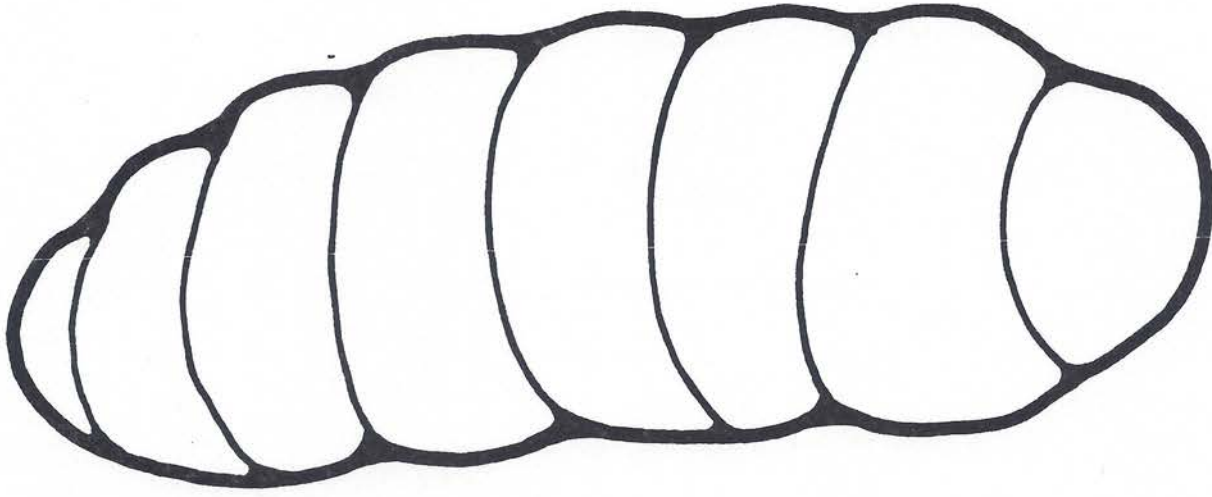


watermelon

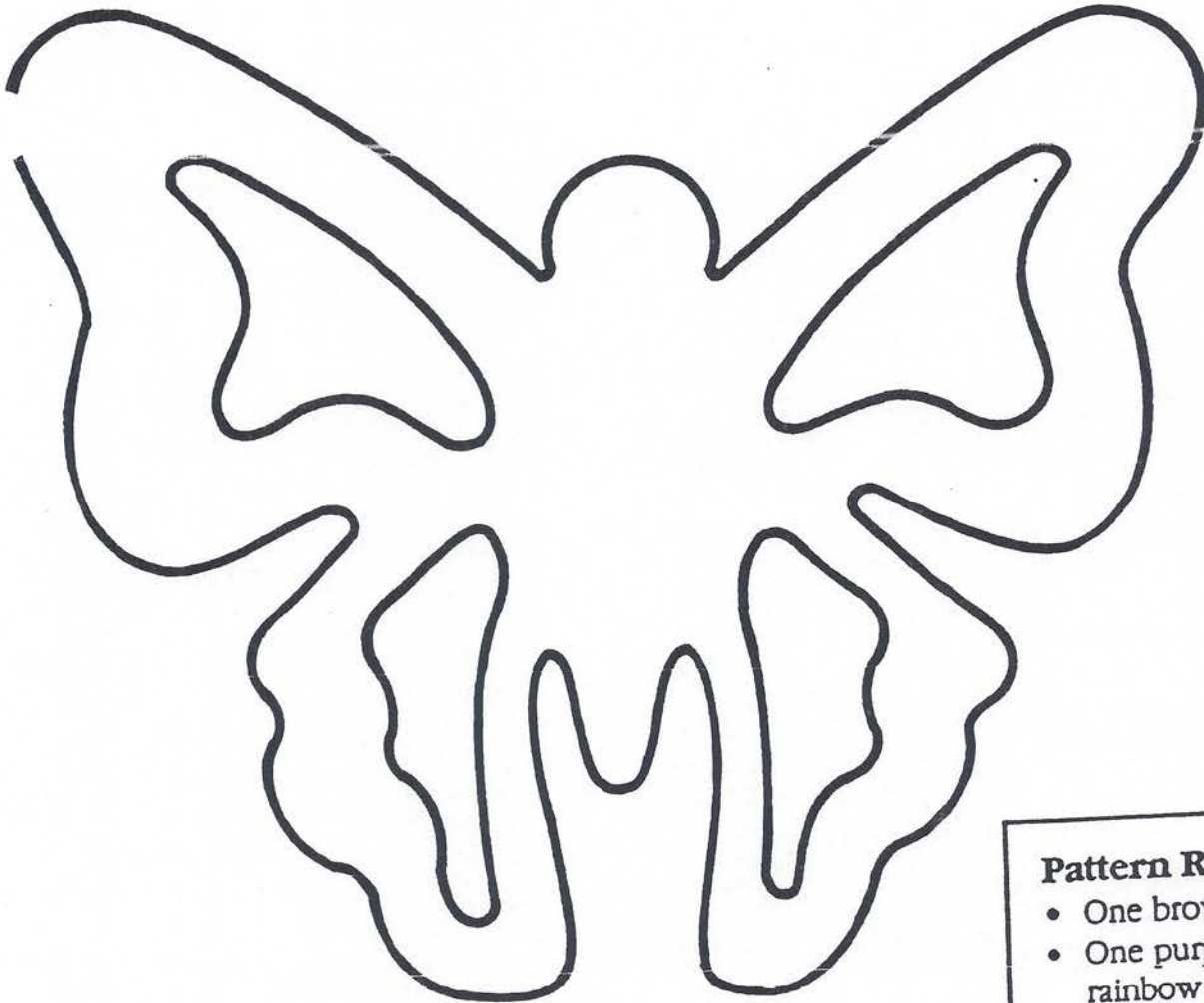
**Pattern Requirements:**
