
You Can Make

Brighten a room with butter-box bugs



- **1.** Take apart a **butter box** and turn it inside out. Re-glue it on all sides.
- 2. Paint the box and decorate it with shapes cut from fabric scraps.
- 3. Add wiggle eyes, a pompom nose, and felt features (including antennae and hands) to one end of the box.
- 4. Cut shoes from cardboard. Punch two holes in each shoe and add yarn laces. Glue the shoes to the bottom of the bug.

- 1. Draw a baseball diamond on poster board.
- 2. For two teams, take 18 baseball cards and give 9 cards to each team.
- 3. Write *Ball*, *Foul Ball*, *Hit*, and *Strike* on slips of paper, and place them in a baseball hat.
- 4. Write Single, Double, Triple, and Home Run on slips of paper, and place them in a second baseball hat.
- 5. To bat, select from the first hat. If a hit is drawn, select a slip of paper from the second hat. Play ball following the rules of baseball. Use the baseball cards as players, and move them around the diamond.
