


Happy New Year

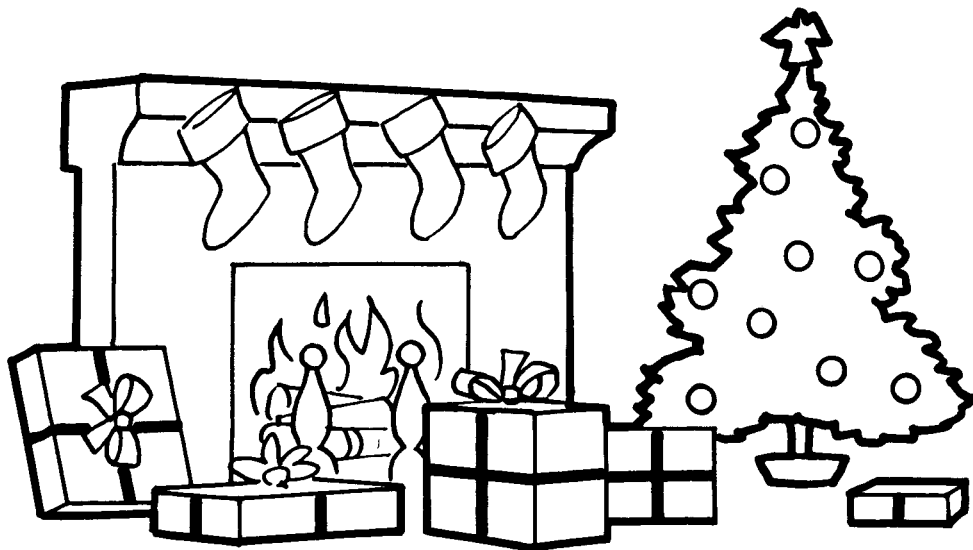

Hanukkah is celebrated by people who are Jewish. It lasts for eight days in November or December.

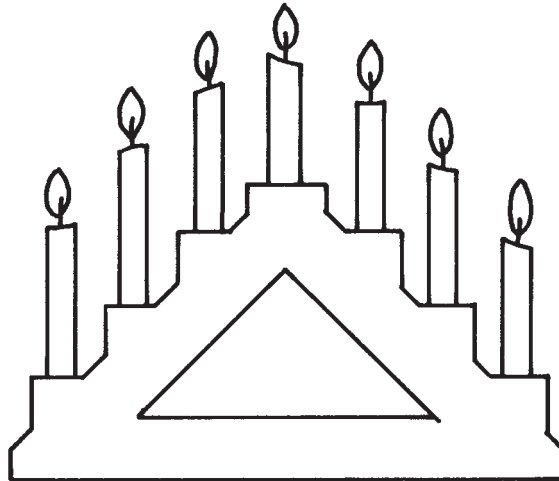

Christmas is a Christian holiday that is celebrated on December 25.

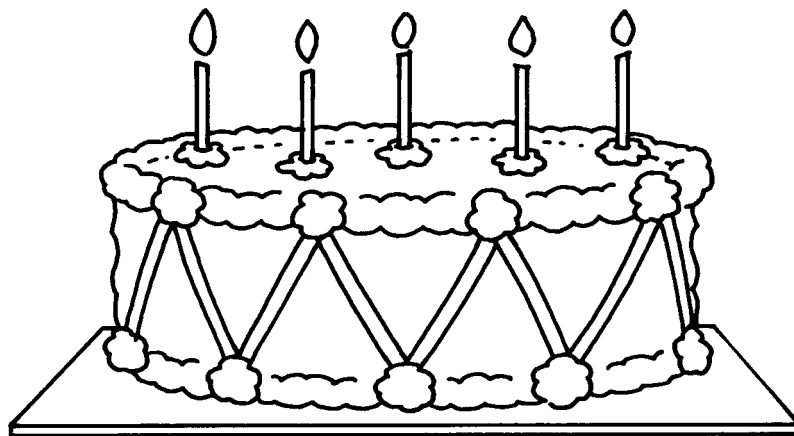
