

Project: Coat Hanger Clothes Dryer (Courtesy of William Hertzog, Cub Pack 339, Reading, PA)

Materials: Wooden clothes hanger  
String  
5 - wooden clip (spring) clothes pins

- Instructions:
- 1) Drill six holes equally spaced in coat hanger
  - 2) Drill a hole in the top of each clothes pin
  - 3) Smooth around holes with sandpaper
  - 4) Paint or shellac at this point if desired
  - 5) Tie string at hole at one end of hanger
  - 6) Slide string through clothes pin and up into 2nd hole. Knot string at 2nd hole leaving a small loop in string between the 1st and 2nd hole. Continue this step using the remaining holes and clothes pins.

This makes a nice traveling gift for mom or dad for drying small articles such as bathing suits, socks, stockings, etc.
