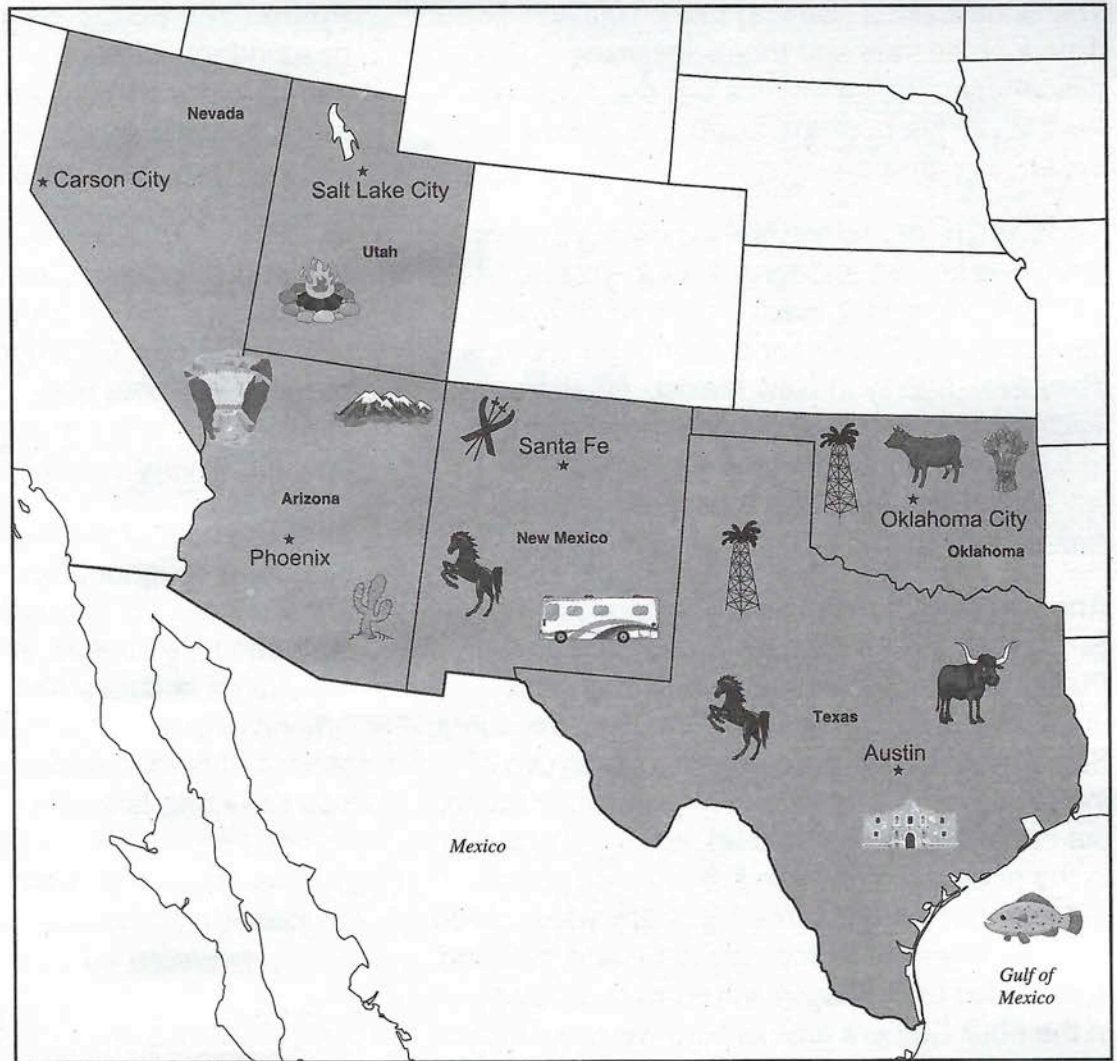


# Human Geography in the Southwest
