## Materials:

shallow, lidless box wooden clothespins rubber jar rings Magic Marker (or felt-tipped pen)

## Cost:

Most materials will be on hand; rubber jar rings cost 37 cents for two boxes.

## Instructions:

- A. Invert box and stick clothespins through. Let the boys decide how many pins to use and how many points each is worth.
- B. Mark number of points on box.
- C. Boys stand a certain distance away (about five feet, depending on skill) and try to throw the jar rings over the clothespins.

Note: Mrs. York reports that this is a good "gathering time" activity for boys in her Den.
