Word Bingo Directions

Play this game with your family or friends.

You'll Need:

- the word bingo game boards
 from page 31
- the clue cards from page 33
- 20 markers (coins, beans, pebbles, paper clips, etc.)

How to Play:

- Shuffle the clue cards and leave them face down.
- Each player takes a game board. It's okay if other players see your board.
- Have someone who is not playing read the clue cards out loud.

If a word clue is called that matches a word on your board, cover that word with a marker. If that word appears on your board more than once, you may only cover one of the words at a time.

You may place a marker on the Wild Word square in response to any clue in the game. You can only use the Wild Word square one time and cannot mark another word in the same turn.

The first player to cover five squares in a row (across, up and down, or diagonally) wins the game.


If you use up all the clue cards before someone wins, reshuffle the clue cards and use them again.
